

Rector's Letter

Shamus Williams

Do you have memories of a teacher when you were at school, who inspired you? For me, it was Mr. Robson, who taught us English, although I was fortunate in having other memorable teachers as well. Mr. Robson had been a distinguished actor before taking up teaching, including work with The Royal Shakespeare Company. After retiring as a teacher, he returned for a while to acting, even playing a leading role at The National Theatre, when he stood in for Alec McCowen, who was indisposed through illness. In the classroom, Mr. Robson didn't shy away from his acting days, playing all the parts as he read us "David Copperfield". The school was on the flightpath to Heathrow, so very noisy planes, including Concorde, would regularly pass overhead. One day, when a particularly noisy one passed over, he pulled out an aerosol can from his desk, went over and opened the window, and boldly pointed it at the jumbo jet, as you might an annoying insect. Those humorous moments from school days stay with you, don't they?

Other stories of eccentric teachers I have come across include "During an A-level lesson my teacher was struggling to draw a bird's wing to illustrate mechanics. He suddenly cleaned the blackboard and left the classroom without saying a word. A couple of minutes later he returned holding a live chicken — no idea where he got it — and proceeded with the lesson as if nothing odd was happening." and "One time, my English teacher told us that he would have a substitute the next day. We came to class and, five minutes after the bell, he showed up in a giant fur coat, a fake mustache, a fur hat, and was speaking in a thick Russian accent. He was pretending to be a dead Russian author and the skit went on for 30 minutes until his mustache started falling off."

It was a pleasure before Christmas to play a small role in a short film shot by a class at Steeple Morden School. It was all about some children finding out about the true meaning of Christmas. It was a very creative idea by the class teacher, and I have no doubt the children involved will remember it for many years hence.

Thank God for our teachers, I say.






