# In the Garden

Insects are important for pollinating our fruit, vegetable and flowering plants and their existence is being threatened from several environmental forces. These include the loss of wildflower habitats, climate change, pesticides and diseases. Gardening for wildlife has become more important than ever, so here are some things you can actively do to make your garden an insect friendly environment.

Garden without using pesticides and herbicides because they disrupt the lifecycle of many animals and kill bees.

Grow nectar-rich plants which will provide food for bees and other insects throughout the year. In the winter, plants such as snowdrops, Christmas Box (Sarcococca), winter flowering honeysuckle (Lonicera x purpusii,) Mahonias, and evergreen clematis Clematis cirrhosa), are all in flower and rich in nectar that insects can feed on. Taking time to inhale the delicious scent that these plants produce is also great garden therapy for human beings.

As most plants flower in the spring and summer, there's always plenty of pollen and nectar around at that time of year. But to give the insects an even better chance, try growing plants which are especially nectar rich. The University of Cambridge has a really attractive bee border full of plants that insects can feast on, and a helpful list of suitable plants to grow which can be downloaded from their website. My favourite plants in this category include foxgloves, lavender, Iris sibirica, and salvias.

Plants which continue to flower into autumn will extend the availability of food for bees and other insects. These include the tall and airy Verbena bonariensis, Cosmos and Devil's bit scabious and sedums. Mature ivy plants produce nectar rich flowers in the autumn providing sustenance for butterflies, bees, hoverflies and the resulting fruit is eaten by blackbirds and thrushes over winter.

#### Grow a patch of nectar rich flowers.

Many hardy annuals and wild flowers that are great for insects including bees and butterflies, are very easy to cultivate. Candytuft, Nigella, cornflowers, Californian poppies, ox-eye daisies, and yarrow are just a few examples. These can be sown outside in the garden from now through to May. Create a patch of weed-free soil which is broken down to a fine texture. Make grooves in the soil about 1-2 cms deep and 15cms apart. Water them thoroughly. Sprinkle the seeds thinly into the grooves and rake

the soil back over, gently firming it down with the your hand or the back of a rake. Protect the area from cats and birds by placing some mesh over it. Water regularly to keep the soil moist. When the seedlings emerge they should be thinned out so that they don't become too overcrowded. Many hardy annuals flower within three months of sowing.

#### Make bug hotels to provide shelter for insects.

This is something children might enjoy being involved in. The bug houses can be very visually imaginative constructions. Made from recycled materials such as corrugated card, pieces of wood as well as hollow stems of reeds, grasses, sections of bamboo canes and even broken roof tiles and air bricks, they will provide homes for ladybirds and a whole host of insects to hibernate in. There are many youtube videos online explaining how to construct them.

March is such a beautiful month as everything bursts into life so I hope you get a chance to enjoy watching the wildlife in your garden.


