Rector's Letter

Shamus Williams

Early November may be called "the season of remembrance". As well as Remembrance Sunday, at the beginning of the month, there is All Saints' Day and All Souls' Day. All Saints' celebrates men and women in whose lives the Church as a whole has seen the grace of God powerfully at work. All Souls' (or as it is sometimes called, The Commemoration of the Faithful Departed), has a more local and intimate feel, allowing us to remember with thanksgiving before God those whom we have known more directly: those who gave us life, or who nurtured us in faith. This year, we will have a service using Zoom focussing on this. That is on Sunday 1st November at 3pm (please note change of time). Please email me at shamuswilliams@waitrose.com and I can give you the details you'll need to join the service online. When we have held this service in a church, we have usually provided tea. We can't do that this year, but I hope you can share a "cuppa" online. What could we call that? A Zoom Brew? (join from 2.30pm for that). Also, in Steeple Morden church, in the area of the side altar (far left hand side of the nave), pebbles will be provided on which to write the name of a loved one you will be remembering.

At the time of writing, it is permitted to hold remembrance ceremonies outside on Remembrance Sunday. I hope this will remain the position. No services in church buildings will be held that day, but there will be 7 ceremonies of remembrance across these villages. Details in calendar of services in Prospect. Please note: where applicable, ie Abington Pigotts, Litlington, Steeple Morden, Guilden Morden and Wendy, people are asked to gather in the churchyard, and to avoid congregating in the street. Please carefully observe the two metre distance between people or households. Thank you.

The Collect for All Souls' Day:

Everlasting God, our maker and redeemer, grant us, with all the faithful departed, the sure benefits of your Son's saving passion and glorious resurrection, that, in the last day, when you gather up all things in Christ, we may with them enjoy the fullness of your promises; through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord, who is alive and reigns with you, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, one God, now and for ever. Amen.

In the Garden

It's been raining walnuts in our garden for the past few weeks. The driveway is littered with the split green husks which encase the delicious brown seeds. A number of squirrels have moved in and have been competing with us to collect them. Their irate chirps and clicking vocalisations leave us in no doubt that they regard us as the intruders. Unlike last year, when we didn't get a single walnut, this season there's enough for everyone to share. Until I moved here some twenty five years ago, I had only ever seen a walnut tree once. So, I was not too surprised to find that many people have no idea what a walnut looks like growing on a tree; that it is encased by a green tough shiny fruit which splits open when ripe. Oh! And I find the taste of fresh walnuts is wonderful and nothing like the dried, hard nuts we traditionally eat at Christmas. Walnuts make a delicious pesto, instead of pine nuts. Just blend together basil, walnuts, olive oil, salt and pepper for a vegan version, or add cheese, to produce a tasty addition to pasta. Walnuts are nutritionally very healthy because of the omega 3 oils, minerals and vitamins they contain.

This year's extreme weather, the warm spring and summer, combined with some very wet conditions in August, has provided us with a

pretty good fruit harvest. Plums and greengages were plentiful, unlike last year, and we have had more delicious apples than we could ever eat. However, we have noticed some fruit have split in a way that we've not encountered before, and maybe that's because of the dry early summer preceding the incredibly wet late August.

Some trees in my garden have succumbed to the unusual meteorological conditions. A perfectly healthy-looking hazelnut died in the dry summer of 2018. I am guessing it had too much competition for water from other nearby trees, and this year we lost a plum and an Arbutus unedo (Strawberry tree) whose leaves became scorched by the prolonged hot sunny spells. I am guessing that the plant communities are going to have to adapt very quickly in order to survive, or perhaps we are going to have to garden in a different way to keep them alive.

November sees the start of the bare root season and is a great time for planting all kinds of fruit, including raspberries, gooseberries, and currants. Apples, pears, and nut trees can also be planted now. I can recommend the eating apple varieties D'Arcy Spice and Pitmaston Pineapple as both have a great taste. 'Onward' is probably my favourite pear because it combines the delicious flavour of a 'Comice' with the vigour and ease of growth of a 'Conference'.

Guilden Morden is to have its own community orchard, a project started by Mr Paget-Wilkes a couple years ago, which has finally come to fruition. (Sorry about the pun). Much hard work has already been done, clearing the site, and in November planting the bare root trees begins. Anyone interested in helping is very welcome. 
