Rector's Letter

Fifty days of partying for millennia

It seems hard to believe that 1700 years ago, there was a meeting of bishops of the Church who came up with a nice way of summarising what Christians believe. This was a crucial document which we still remember, read, contemplate and pray with today Churches

on a weekly basis. The document is called the Creed, and the meeting was the first council of the entire Church. It took place in Nicaea, present-day Turkey.

Truth be told, too much blood and suffering came because of disagreements before and after this creed. In fact the motivation for such council was for the emperor to ensure that a clear Christian message could be spread throughout the entire Byzantine empire. The way to secure such success was for those opposing the canon, that is the mainstream ideology of Christianity, in small pockets of the empire), to pass through the sword. None of this is worthy praising or honouring.

However, what it is worthy honouring and remembering is that genius of the Creed. In it the Nicean creed contains deep and difficult theological concepts made accessible and simple to everybody. Any person from any walk of life and from all backgrounds is able to abide to it and believe it wholeheartedly. Yet, one can spend a whole life investigating the ramifications of the statements of the Nicaean Creed and never exhaust its full meaning. This is because we are talking about God, a God who is infinite and can be known for ever.

In one part of the creed, it can be read that Jesus Christ 'suffered under Pontius Pilate, died and was buried.' But also that 'he rose again according to Scriptures.'

Pontius Pilate gives us the geo-historical background; it happened in a concrete place and at a concrete time. The term 'according to Scriptures' gives us the notion that the fulfilment of what was promised long ago (in Holy Scripture) took place in Jesus Christ. Christians therefore proclaim a historical event, that really took place. Christians proclaim with this Creed that, despite the impossibility of people coming back to life, this Jesus did it.

As a Christian myself I find great comfort in believing through the Creed. The resurrection of Christ is the biggest event of the Christian faith. It has transformed millions of people and it has transformed my life. Easter is the celebration of such resurrection.

What not many people know is that Easter is not just one day a year. Easter started last month, in April. It continues for fifty days of celebration in the life of the Church, and it continues in our Christian hearts for eternity. Alleluia!



Ashwell and Bassingbourn Patients Group

Following Dr Jarvis' retirement, we are pleased to welcome Dr Hasham in his place on the ABPG. We also welcome Dr Hussain who has been appointed to replace Dr Jarvis. Discussions are in hand to appoint an additional doctor. We were very sad to lose much-appreciated Jasmine as our Physician Assistant. However our two new doctors will be offering increased hours so clinical capacity should be unaffected.

We were delighted to learn that Dr Hasham has qualified as a tutor for GP trainee doctors ("Registrars"). We generally have two registrars and they provide valuable additional consultations for our patients. Not all surgeries enjoy this arrangement.

Two developments to report :

- Adjustable seats have been provided at blood pressure machines in our waiting rooms. Users please select the appropriate height before using the machines.
- Tablets will be installed in our waiting rooms (a) for the benefit of patients with no IT access or limited skills, and (b) to enable discreet communication with reception. These have worked well in other practices.

The Frailty Hub is going extremely well with 20 participants regularly attending the weekly sessions which include physical and social activities. Ours is the only such hub in N Herts to have links with the GP practice. Thanks to the Ashwell URC for generously hosting. More members very welcome. Just turn up! You don't have to live in Ashwell to join.

In the Kitchen



GRUYERE, THYME AND ROASTED SHALLOT SCONES

Makes 8

Ingredients:

A few tablespoons of olive oil 80g shallots (peeled) 450g self-raising flour 1 tsp baking powder 125g unsalted butter (cubed) 1 tsp sea salt 1 tsp black pepper 1 tbsp fresh thyme (finely chopped) 120g Gruyere cheese (grated) 1 egg 150ml milk (plus extra to brush on top)

Preheat the oven to 220° and line a baking sheet with parchment paper. Leave the baking sheet in the oven whilst you are making your scones.

Cut the shallots into rough quarters and drizzle with olive oil in a baking dish, roast in the oven for 20 minutes. Once cooled cut up into small pieces.

In a large mixing bowl, rub the butter into the flour and baking powder until the mix resembles breadcrumbs. Next stir in the salt, pepper, thyme, and most of the cheese (leaving a little for the top of the scones) and then gently mix in the chopped shallots to the dry ingredients.

Make a well in the middle of the dry ingredients, and pour in the combined egg and milk liquid, mix together to form a soft dough.

Bring the dough together on a lightly floured surface to form a ball, it is important to not overwork the dough to avoid it becoming tough. Roll the dough out to 3-4 cm thick and with a 78mm cookie cutter portion out your scones.

Brush the tops lightly with milk and sprinkle the remaining cheese onto the scones.

Bake for 12 to 15 minutes until they have turned golden brown and risen well. Transfer to a cooling rack and then enjoy.

These are delicious paired with some chutney or jam or just butter and are a perfect way to welcome the summer! Happy Baking! STEEPLE MORDEN BOWLS CLUB






