

The month of September has carried many mixed emotions in me for years. I think it has to do with the fact that more than thirty years of my life (and I have not yet reached my forties) I have spent in the world of academia in one way or another. And

September has always been the season of beginning the course. While I said goodbye to wonderful hot summers of enjoyment, September would be my blue January; back to the daily routine of studying hard and the beginning of the cold season.

Yet, where the summer ends, autumn starts to show its face. New opportunities would come my way. I still remember the September when I first took French language, and how my father would correct my pronunciation of the verbs in the infinitive as I read the brand-new textbook.

In the life of the Church, September could be qualified as the beginning of the end. We continue ordinary time until we reach the end of the liturgical year. Then we give way to the new one with advent.

In the USA, one of my countries of nationality, September is the time when people are allowed to start making plans for autumn without social judgement, and they can finally give in to the pressures of big supermarkets which had been offering Pumkin-Spice Latte and Halloween decorations since late July.

Perhaps this hectic dance of starting news things and getting ready to finish old ones can make this month seem intimidating. What will the (academic) year ahead be? How tough will next winter be? How much spring cabbage or onion will I plant this autumn?

On the other hand, I get excited starting new things. I think even all the different martial-arts that I tried throughout my childhood begun in September. My favourites were Aikido and Taekwondo.

In September we also start getting nature's true colours. As Christian author Sally Lloyd-Jones says in her wonderful book *Thoughts to Make Your Heart Sing*: "In the autumn, trees produce less chlorophyll, the green fades, and so the leaves show their true colors – blazing reds, yellows, golds! ... And the Bible says you can't see all you really are either. But one day, when God mends his broken world once and for all, you'll be all he made you to be – and then your true colours will come shining through."

can put us at an advantage with some distance from a New Year's resolution or "Operation Bikini" (as it is known in Spain) in preparation for summer.

I believe that the Shingay Churches can be a great training centre for the next generation of bellringers to learn and enjoy this long and relevant tradition of our English culture. By listening to one another and making things beautiful we can show our true colours to the world.


