Roughie

I do not have any cats but there are a few cats that often pay a visit to my garden. Over time I have guessed that they are stray cats. One is goldenorange so I call him Garfield. There is another one that is black/grey and white. I call this one Roughie.

Roughie got that name because he always carries a menacing and defiant look and does not stick around for too long.

Apparently, he has a reputation of being mean to other cats. Cat owners mention how Roughie comes into their gardens and attack their own pet cats.

Not that long ago, I witnessed a conversation on social media where some of our neighbours were alerting the community that Roughie has been recently spotted injured. He seems to be limping and in pain. Yet, living up to his name, he would not let himself be taken care of. Even though he is injured, his tyranny of hurting other cats goes unstopped.

There was something that really warmed my heart. One local cat owner said, if anyone was able to get hold of him, she would be still willing to take him to the vet. In the conversation thread it was very obvious that Roughie does not deserve good treatment because he goes around hurting his own kind. He is not loveable, nor kind. He does not receive food or cares with gratitude, and he is out there to hurt. Yet, none of that stopped this person from extending grace and be willing to help him out.

Like Roughie, I too like walking out and about through the villages of the Shingay Churches and I was able to think about this act of kindness a bit further. In this gesture of the neighbour, I find fundamental Christian values of unconditional love, grace and community: Unconditional love in that there is love extended without reservations or conditions. It is not what is deserved, but what the loving-kindness of the lover gives. Grace, in that it is a gift unexpected, and not sought for. And lastly there is community, there is a communal concern for the well-being of this creature of God who is clearly suffering.

I was reminded that in Christianity even suffering has a purpose. Suffering can draw us closer to God or draw others closer to God. Everything in our life has meaning; nothing in our life is meaningless.

I also think how radically different would our community be, if we were all concerned for one another just as we are concerned for Roughie.

If Spring begins with the Elder leaves breaking, then Summer begins with elder-flower, now in full throttle (spoiler alert: Summer ends with elderberries). Notice the heady-sweet smell of elderflowers when walking along hedgerows.

Always look up into the skies when you hear the urgent alarm call of a Swallow. They have the acutest eyesight for a predator. The two times I have seen a Merlin over my house has been thanks to our resident Swallows vociferously and courageously chasing them off.

I have never seen a Swallow catch a butterfly on the wing. Have you? You would think a butterfly would be such easy prey. It is not as if butterflies are inedible. In our church, there were often butterfly wings on the floor, which were a give-away for the presence of bats, which nip off the butterfly wings before swallowing the body. Merlin, also catch both butterfly and dragonfly on the wing, picking them out of the air with a claw, before delicately consuming the insect in bite-sized chunks.

And do Swallows hunt honey bees? Swifts can often be seen above beehives, however, David Lack's *Swifts in a Tower* reviews the findings of Swifts shot (I know!) and dissected for evidence of honey bee predation. Apparently, Swifts will only take the stingless Drone (male) bee, which doesn't make honey. It is impressive that they make the distinction (albeit, the Drone is larger than the Worker bee).

Hot summer afternoons, I find, can often have the soundscape of monotony, with no cadence to capture your heart, as in Spring, when the Warblers are... well... warbling. Now, however, the Chiffchaff is incessantly chiff.. chiff.. chaff'ing; the Greenfinch's distinctive wheeze is irritating; the coo of the Woodpigeon can seem endless, and the Yellowhammer's "Little bit of bread and no cheese" is repetitive. According to Miriam Darlington, the Yellowhammer's call may have inspired Beethoven's opening bars for his Symphony No. 5 in C minor (you know the one... "Da-Da-Da-Daaah). The name, Yellowhammer, comes from the Anglo-Saxon *Yellow ammer*, meaning yellow bunting, but they are also called the Scribble lark, or Scribe, because their off-white eggs are scribbled in purplish-brown.

It is well worth a visit to our Clunch pit wood. You may be privileged enough to find a Grass snake or a Slow worm up there, and you can see butterflies such as the Speckled Wood (brown but speckly), the Small Heath (orangey-russet; usually sits with wings folded up); the Meadow Brown (larger, darker, with russet flashes underwing) and the Marbled White (pied).

Next to the Clunch pit wood is our Wellhead Spring and I have often wondered why there were so few Minnows and Stickleback in the pool there (and correspondingly rare sightings of the Kingfisher). Many of the "Spot-on" flea *continued overleaf* **In**

and tick protection for dogs, contains *Imidacloprid* and *Fipronil*, which were banned in farming 10 years ago as too toxic, particularly to aquatic invertebrates. Perhaps the accumulation of dogs swimming in the Wellhead Spring has had an effect on the invertebrates and, in consequence, the fish that feed on the insect life in the water. In October 2023, over twenty NGOs', including Wildlife Trusts, RSPB, Rivers Trusts and Angling Trusts, signed an open letter to Government calling for action. In this letter they pointed out that and I quote: "A single dose on a large dog of the neonicotinoid *Imidacloprid* – commonly found in tick and flea treatments – is enough to kill millions of honey bees". Which, if true, is quite startling (speaking as a beekeeper). But what to do about it? Apparently, one can switch to tablets and also make sure dog poo is bagged and disposed of appropriately.

Hemlock flowers at this time of year— the UK's most deadly plant and the one that Socrates was forced to drink upon his death sentence in 399 BC. Found alongside water, it smells of mice and has hairless stems with purple blotches. Beware. It may look like Cow parsley or Wild carrot but its purple blotches on the stems and shiny leaf, tell it apart.

The Strawberry moon is on 11th June. And finally, a collective noun to warm your hearts: for ladybirds, it is a "loveliness"!


