Letter from our village churches

Easter in Guilden Morden this year was very special, because, after three years of pandemic restrictions, we were finally able to return to some semblance of normality.

It was a moving experience to walk with the cross through the village on Good Friday, singing hymns at various points. A week earlier, our Palm Sunday service began with the blessing of the palms and a procession outside the church – bearing a banner with an image of Jesus on the donkey. It was cold and windy, but we marched valiantly along the path, with an occasional cry of "Hosanna! Jesus is our king!" echoing through the village.

The third century rabbi, Shemuel ben Nachmani, said that: "We do not see things as they are. We see things as we are." I think this is very true of people's reactions to Jesus at different points in their lives. On the original Palm Sunday, crowds cheered for Jesus as their king – but a short time later, many of those same people were calling for his death. Their feelings had changed; they were disappointed by a 'king' who promoted peace, not war against their Roman oppressors.

Even Mary Magdalene, who was the first person to meet Jesus after he rose on Easter morning (John 20:11-18), saw things unclearly because of her own situation. Weeping in the garden by the empty tomb, she did not immediately recognise Jesus, even when he spoke to her

Many have pondered why this was the case. Why did Mary not recognise the man she had followed and believed in for so long? Was she blinded by the rising sun? Were her eyes blurred by tears of grief? Did she not know Jesus or his voice simply because she was not expecting him to be there? Was his risen form so transformed from the suffering man she had last seen that he was quite unfamiliar?

Whatever the reason, it's clear that when he said her name, her eyes were suddenly opened and she knew him. My prayer this month is that we are all able to recognise Jesus, especially if pain or grief, or the burdens of our daily lives, may have blurred our eyes. And keep your ears open too - because he calls each of us by name.



At the moment the fashion in gardening is very much geared towards using grasses and perennials. But, unless they are packed in tightly, with plenty of dense ground-covering plants, such borders require a lot of maintenance. Many of us simply don't have the time for that. So, I have been looking for plants that are easier to manage such as shrubs and climbers. Here's a small selection of the ones I like to use.

The flowering quince, *Chaenomeles*, is a rather lovely medium-sized shrub that flowers in spring when little else is providing colour. It looks good trained against a wall and needs a reasonable amount of sun to flower well. The flowers can be rich reds, orange, pink and white and they grow in clusters along dark brown angular stems.

Viburnum davidii is a shrub I use in gardens to provide evergreen structure. It forms heavy mounds of dark green leaves that are narrowly elliptical, ribbed and glossy. Its tiny white flowers, emerging in spring, are uninteresting in comparison to its leaves. However, on female plants these turn into egg-shaped bluish berries later in the year. It will grow in sun or light shade and prefers a moist but well drained soil.

Climbing plants, with the exception of roses, are relatively under-used in gardens. Maybe, it's because ivy, which can loosen the mortar between bricks on a wall, has given them a bad reputation. But there are many that are not such hooligans, make their way upwards without destroying the supporting structure, twining their stems along wires or trelliswork instead.

An example is clematis; versatile climbers that can be used as screening or to hide ugly structures such as garages and sheds. *Clematis montana* are great for this because they are fast growing with dense foliage. They mainly have pink, white or cream medium- sized flowers that appear in late spring. Some clematis, such as the *C. jackmanii* varieties, begin to bloom just as the roses are fading and these are invaluable for bridging that gap between July and September when little else is in flower. These clematis also brighten trees if allowed to clamber up their branches.

Once planted, shrubs and climbers need very little attention. If the right size of plant is chosen for its space, they will only require the removal of the flowering branches once the flowers have died off. However, they do need a bit of care during their first year after planting; watering once a week with a couple of gallons of water, especially during the summer, is essential. A thick mulch over the soil surrounding the plant will keep the weeds at bay and the ground underneath moist; especially if the summer is dry. A late winter feed of an organic fertiliser will speed up their growth.

I hope this article has whetted your appetite for growing more shrubs and climbers and saving you some time to enjoy the garden instead.


