Rector's Letter

Shamus Williams

This summer has been a lively one in the land of The Church of England's Twittersphere (is that a word?). Some clergy and laity alike reacted strongly to a report suggesting parochial clergy were "limiting factors", and less than active laity merely "passengers". These phrases were taken as insulting, and plain wrong. A lot of rowing back on the use of these phrases has gone on since then.

I mention this obscure world of church politics, as it has prompted a movement being called "Save the Parish". Some have felt increasingly that concentration of both resources and commitment should be on the life of parish churches, rather than other church outreach, less obviously parochial in nature. This is a huge subject. Not least of the challenges lying ahead for parish churches is the increasing costs and energy needed to maintain the fabric of the buildings. Here as elsewhere, we are grateful to "Friends" groups of the churches who assist with this big task. Ultimately I think some arrangement between the State and The Church Commissioners will have to occur, as fewer and fewer parishioners are able to cope with maintaining so many historic buildings. This and many of the issues which "Save the Parish" is all about is a long way above my "pay grade"! Even if you are not a churchperson, you may have a concern about the church buildings, and I would hope have an interest in local Christian church ministry continuing based on the local ecclesiastical parish. Although I am thinking of The Church of England here, some other denominations may have an interest and concern about the parish too. The parish was described at the "Save the Parish" launch event as where "worship and pastoral care are offered to everyone, and it models an association of ages, classes, and cultures in a place, as the Early Church did", and the parish church building "speaks in itself of other values than the mercenary and the utilitarian. . ."

My impression is that "Save the Parish" has scratched an itch felt in many a parish up and down the land. You can view the launch event here:
